

The Regulatory Services Section is currently monitoring to verify facilities are using an approved curriculum when applicable:

Rule .2802(d) Facilities with a four or five-star rated license that serve four-year-old children must implement a curriculum as defined in 10A NCAC 09 .0102 with their four- year- old children. This applies to Child Care Centers and Family Child Care Homes.

Rule .2829 (2)(a) Quality point option - Using age or developmentally appropriate curriculum that addresses the five domains of development.

The Regulatory Services Section and the Early Educator Support Licensing and Professional Development Office are considering curriculum monitoring options. Three categories have been identified to be monitored: implementation guides, planning process and pre-literacy. More information will be coming soon on how and when these three categories will be monitored.
