

Classroom Management Plan Outline

A classroom management plan should include the following: (you should give a rationale for your choices)

1. Philosophical beliefs – Provide a philosophical statement on your beliefs about classroom management. This should include a description of your teaching style.
2. Room arrangement – Describe your room arrangement. How does it impact children? How does it foster self-regulation and support classroom management?
3. Classroom rules – How are these created? What might these include? How do these foster self-regulation in children? How are these communicated with children, parents, administrators, etc?
4. Classroom schedule (including procedures, routines and transitions) – Describe your daily schedule including procedures, routines and transitions throughout the day. Discuss the intentionality with which it was developed. How do your daily procedures, routines and transitions promote self regulation? How does your daily schedule impact classroom management?
5. Classroom climate – Describe how you foster a positive classroom climate. How do you interact with children? How do your interactions with children foster self-regulation? What approaches do you use to working with children who exhibit challenging behaviors? What strategies and methods do you use to maximize the effectiveness of your classroom management plan?

While addressing each area listed above, briefly identify specific indicators from the PKKTPAI and ECERS-R, objectives from the Creative Curriculum and Widely Held Expectations from *Foundations* that support each element of your classroom management plan.
