The NC Division of Child Development and Office of School Readiness have created a committee to evaluate early childhood curricula. The curricula evaluated by this committee will be 1) approved for use in classrooms that are a part of the More at Four Pre-Kindergarten Program; 2) approved for use by classrooms receiving recognition through the NC Pre-K Standards Initiative; and 3) approved for use by child care programs using curriculum to receive a quality point towards the two component Star Rated License.

The committee members selected to review the curricula are individuals who are experts in the field of early childhood education. Academic institutions, agencies, and program types represented on the committee include: University of North Carolina at Greensboro, Frank Porter Graham Child Development Institute, Appalachian State University, Wake Technical Community College, Child Care Services Association, NC Department of Public Instruction, NC Child Care Commission, Work Family Resource Center, and a religious sponsored five star program. In addition, child care providers of different aged children are a part of the committee.
